



CAMP COUNSELLOR

The Niagara Pumphouse Arts Centre is the art hub that connects our community by providing art for all. Located on the banks of the Niagara River in a heritage building that formerly supplied water to Niagara-on-the-Lake (hence our name); the Niagara Pumphouse Arts Centre offers visual arts programs, exhibitions and events. We give back to the community by providing access to the arts for those in need.

Terms: 30 - 40 hrs./week for 8 - 10 weeks

Responsibilities

- Assist Camp Leader with summer art camp - jr. (ages 4-8) or summer art camp - sr. (ages 9-12) and outreach art activities (in studio/community and/or online) for a not-for-profit arts centre providing visual art programming to children and families from the Niagara Region.
- Plan, organize and deliver recreational and educational activities for outdoor breaks, lunch, and online supplementary kit (additional projects, activities, and prompts).
- Studio and/or online set-up and clean up of equipment and supplies for summer programs schedule including classes, workshops and camps.
- Maintain inventory of art supplies in the studio.
- Work collaboratively with Camp Leader, Camp Counsellors, volunteers and staff to coordinate art camp and outreach activities.
- Occasionally act as Gallery Attendant, responsible for overseeing gallery space and arts administration duties.
- Participate in Team Health & Safety Training and one-on-one job-specific training
- Successfully complete WHMIS online training and certification, First Aid/CPR training & certification and a Vulnerable Sector Check.
