Courage and Sacrifice by Jane Morris (2022)



Jane Morris comes from a long line of artists and has been drawing and painting since an early age. The artist feels happiest when she is with a paint brush in her hand

or planning out her next project.

First Flora by Lindsey Kemp (2019)



Lindsey Kemp is a classically-trained photographic artist, as well as an herbalist. Her winning artwork Pays homage to these two interests.

Metamorphosis by Jennifer Penner (2019)



Jennifer was born and raised in Niagara. The artist focused her winning submission on the metamorphosis of ice wine grapes into icewine.

Lake Sailing by Lynn Weiner (2023)



Working with acrylic, Lynn Weiner produces highly detailed and realistic paintings, using multiple thin layers of colour to build shapes and enhance the perception of three-

dimensionality. Her work is inspired by her community, nature, and the people around her.

Fire at Will by Nancy Wardle (2022)



Nancy Wardle's paintings capture the beauty around using bright, vibrant colours in a loose Impressionistic style. Her works can be found in private collections across Canada and the U.S.

Paint The Town by Brittany Blyth-Williams (2021)



Brittany Blyth-Williams is a Canadian abstract artist known for her lack of fear in utilizing bold colour and brushstrokes. Her process is predominantly inspired by intuition and emotion.
